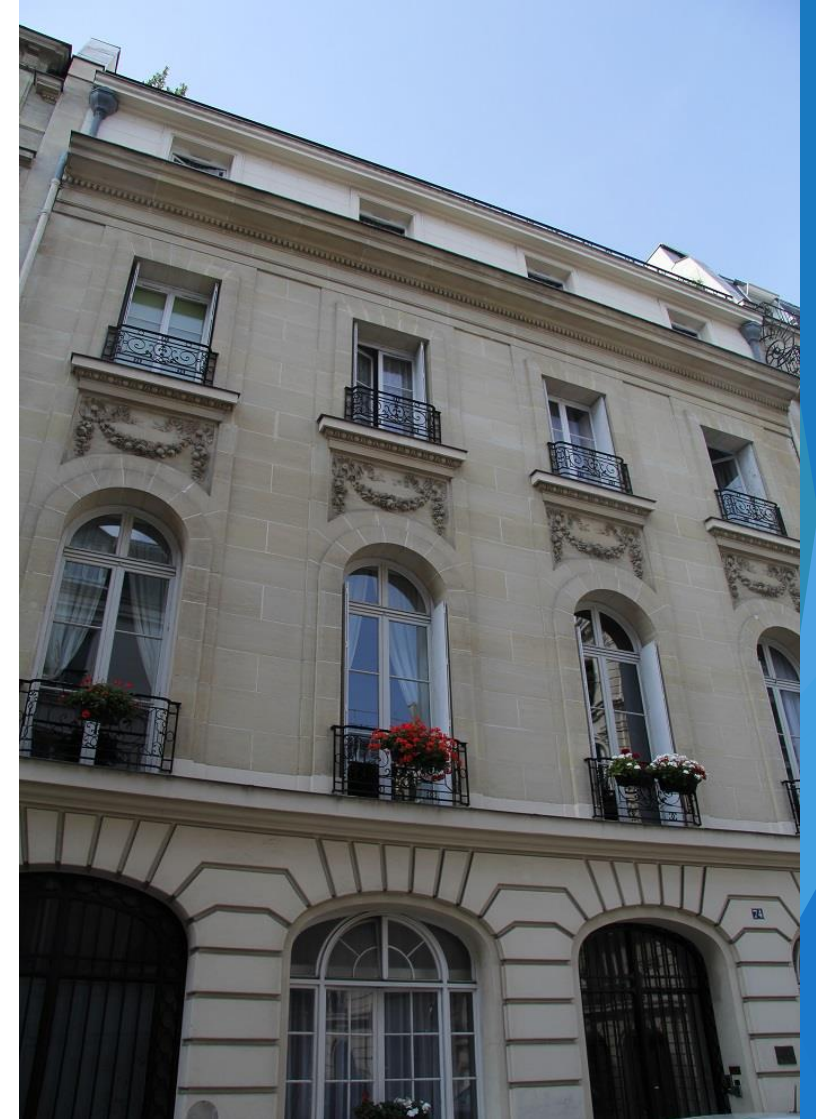

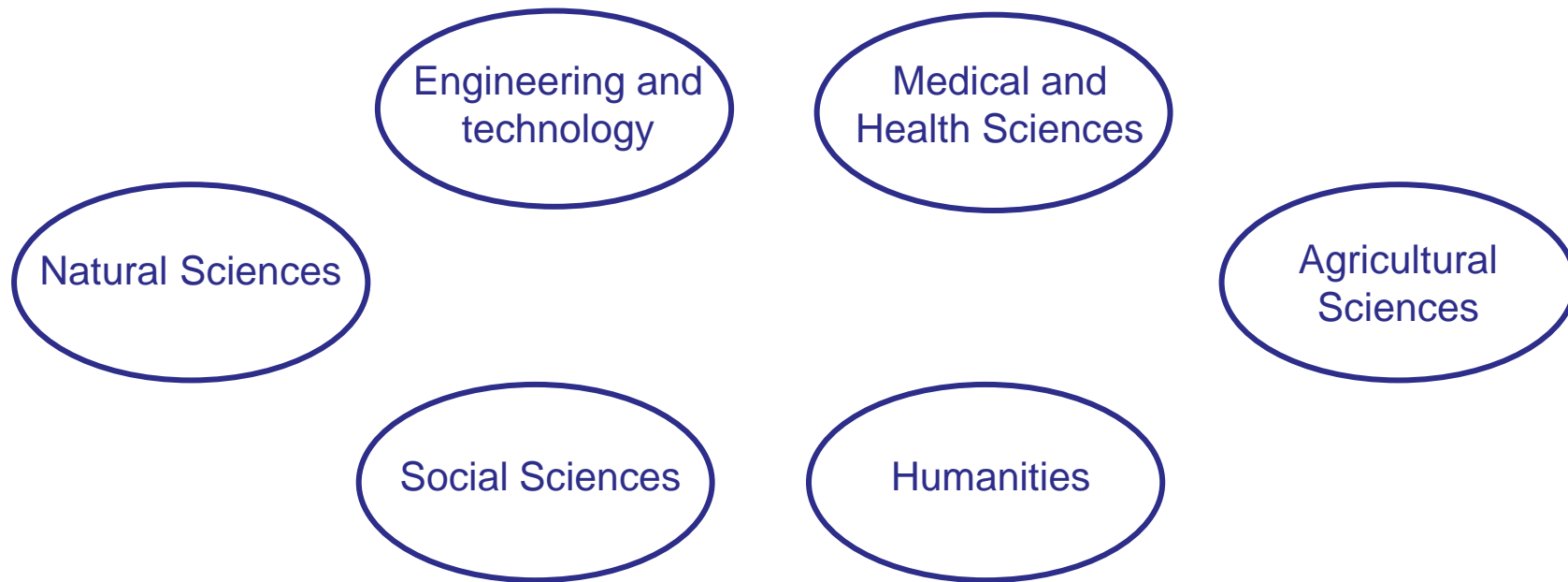

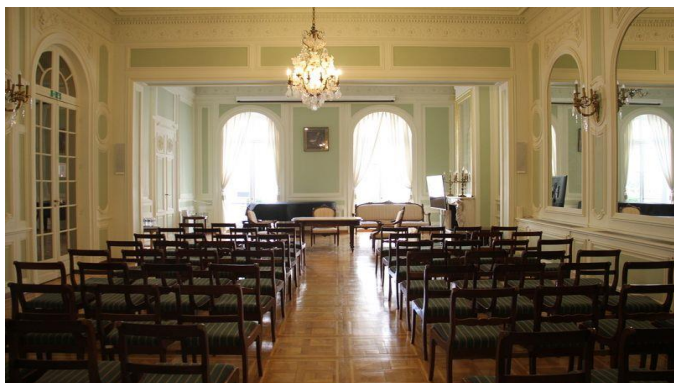
Interdisciplinarity & Multidiscplinary of events

Other activities

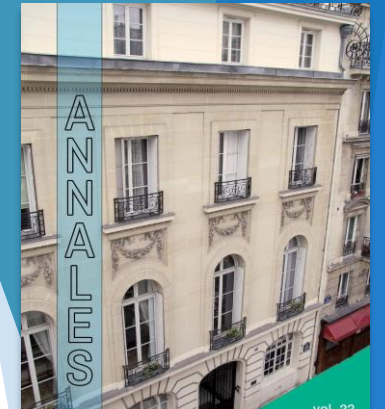
- ▶ Monitoring of French scientific environment

3. Publishing activity

- Since 1998, the PAS Scientific Centre in Paris has been publishing *Annales* (*Roczniki*) which contain texts of conferences, interviews with people of science and memoirs about outstanding scientists
- The Centre co-finances publications important to French-Polish historical, cultural or scientific relations

Library

- The library specializes in documenting the historical and cultural links between France and Poland, the history of Polish science and the diversity of Poland's cultural heritage
- The library has about 10,000 volumes and its book collection is closed



4. Scientific stays at the PAS Scientific Centre in Paris

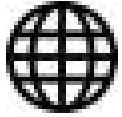
The Centre offers guest rooms
